A Tour Through the RADAR Screen

Once you have started RADAR with one of the above methods, you are ready to begin working with the repertory. It is helpful to familiarize yourself with the RADAR screen before beginning to use it.

When you first start RADAR, you notice an image of a man appears briefly on the screen. This man is Dr. Kent. After this image disappears, the main RADAR repertory view appears. By default, RADAR opens up to the Mind chapter of Synthesis 8.0.
